





### Henry VIII (1491-1547)

- Made England a **Protestant country** so he could divorce.

### Guy Fawkes (1570-1606)

- **Catholic**
- Planned to carry out the **Gunpowder Plot**.



### Emmeline Pankhurst (1858-1928)

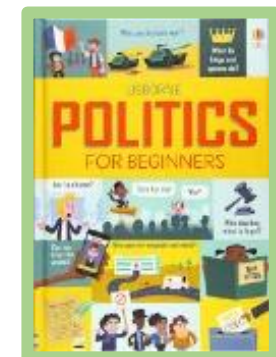
- Leader of the **British suffragette** movement.

## Big Ws: UK Politics

- Has a **monarch** and a **parliament**.
- Leader of the political party with the most MPs becomes **Prime Minister**.
- MPs **debate laws**.
- **Citizens vote** for the MP in their area.



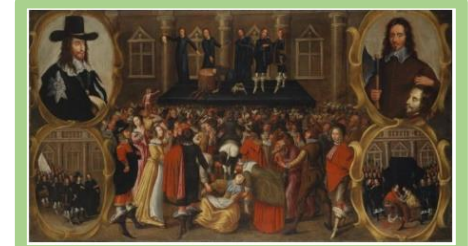
### Big Ws: Henry VIII



- **Catholic** originally, then became **Protestant**.
- Introduced the policy of the **dissolution of the monasteries**.
- Took **land and money** away from the **Roman Catholic Church**.
- Made himself the **new head of the Church of England**.

### Big Ws: Civil War

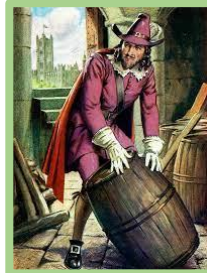
- Fought by **Royalists** (supporters of the **Charles I**) and **Parliamentarians** (supporters of Parliament, led by **Oliver Cromwell**).
- Led to 11 years of England not having a **monarch**.
- **Charles I** was **executed**.

### Big Ws: Gunpowder Plot

- **Plot** to **kill James I** and restore the **Catholic monarchy** from the Church of England.
