

consumer


# **Important People**

**Vocabulary: Digestive System** 

The process of breaking down food and drink digestion

into nutrients that our body can use.

A substance produced by the organs which enzymes

helps to break down food and drink into

nutrients that the body needs.

Liquid produced in the mouth saliva

containing enzymes to begin the

digestive process.



#### Mouth

The first part of the digestive system, where food enters the body.

### Liver

A green liquid, called bile, is stored in your liver and is used to break down fats.

## **Small Intestine**

The long, thing winding tube that food goes through after it leaves the stomach.

#### **Anus**

The opening at the end of the digestive system where faeces (poo) leaves the body.

# **Oesophagus**

Muscles push the food down into your stomach.

#### **Stomach**

Everything is blended with digestive juices. Hydrochloric acid kills bacteria. Enzymes break down proteins.

# **Large Intestine**

The shorter winding tube that follows the small intestine.
