defend



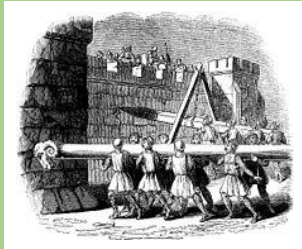
Protect from an **attack**.

Hard solid material that castles are made from.

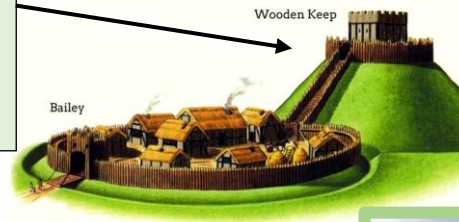
siege

Later the **bailey** was changed to **stone**.

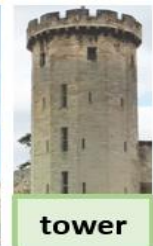


Walls and **towers** collapsed.
