


Fabric threads begin to **unravel**.

**hem**




**Edge** of a piece of fabric **folded** and **sewn**.

**neat**




In an **order**.

**pattern piece**




**Template** used to create **textiles**.

**seam**




**Two pieces** of fabric **joined together**.

## Big Ws: Sewing for appearance



### Gathers

- 1) Run the needle through the fabric using a **running stitch**.
- 2) Pull the fabric.



### Knife Pleats

- 1) **Fold** the fabric into equal parts.
- 2) **Pin** each **pleat**.
- 3) Use **running stitch** across the top of all the **pleats**.



## Big Ws: Stitches


**back stitch:**

- **Strongest stitch.**



**catch stitch:**

- Used for a **flat finish** like a hem.



**running stitch:**

- Simple stitch of **small stitches in a line** without overlapping.
