His **diary** told us what the fire was like.



1666




- Built with **wooden frames** and **straw**.

Big Ws: Key Events

- 1) Fire breaks out. 
- 2) Fire spreads to St. Paul's Cathedral. 
- 3) Fire begins to die down. 
- 4) The last 3 large fires are put out. 
- 5) Houses redesigned and rebuilt. 
- 6) Monument by Sir Christopher Wren is built.
