


Howard Carter (1874 – 1939)


- Archaeologist

Big Ws: Afterlife




- Ancient Egyptians worshipped thousands of gods.

- **Grain** was the first crop they grew **after inundation (flooding season)**.



Big Ws: River Nile


- Farmers **planted crops** in the **rich soil**.
