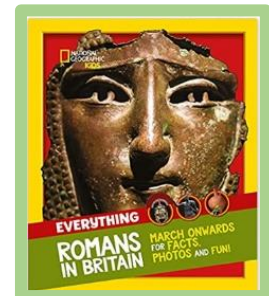
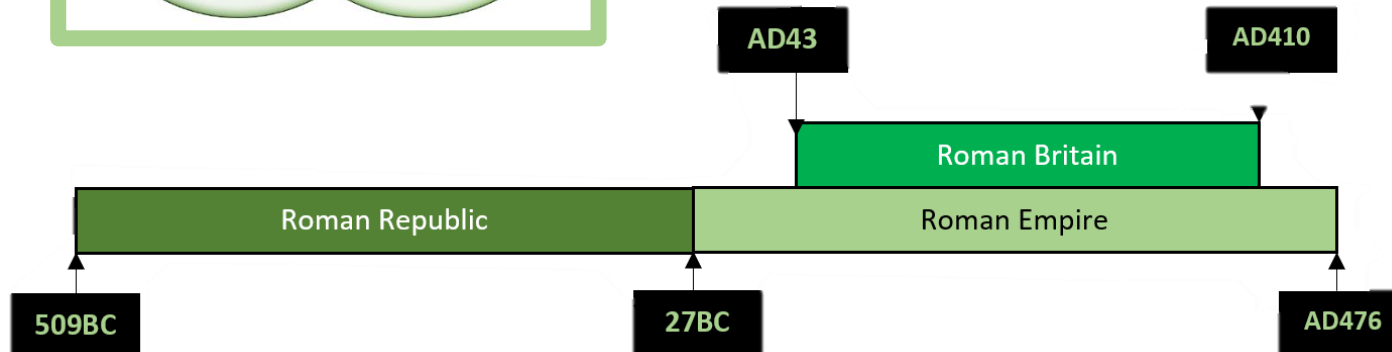
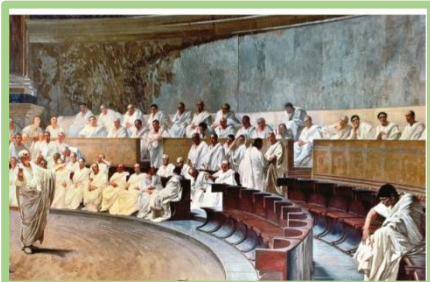
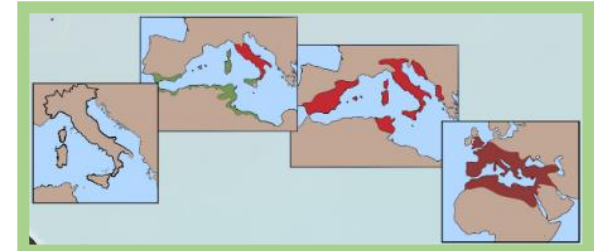
Big Ws: Republic of Rome

Only the strongest soldiers.

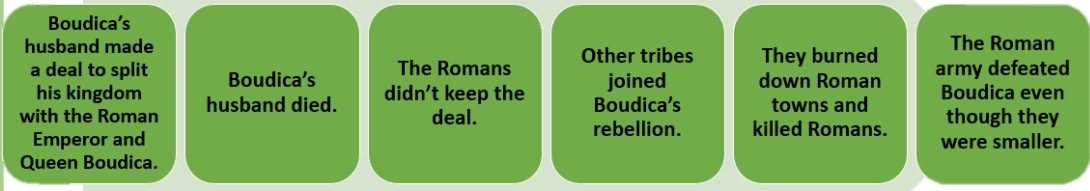
Highly effective equipment.

Fighting formations.

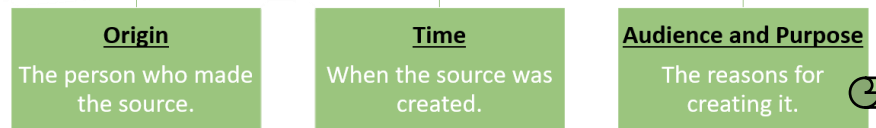


Big Ws: Boudicca's Revolt

Historians consider different things to decide **how reliable** a source is.

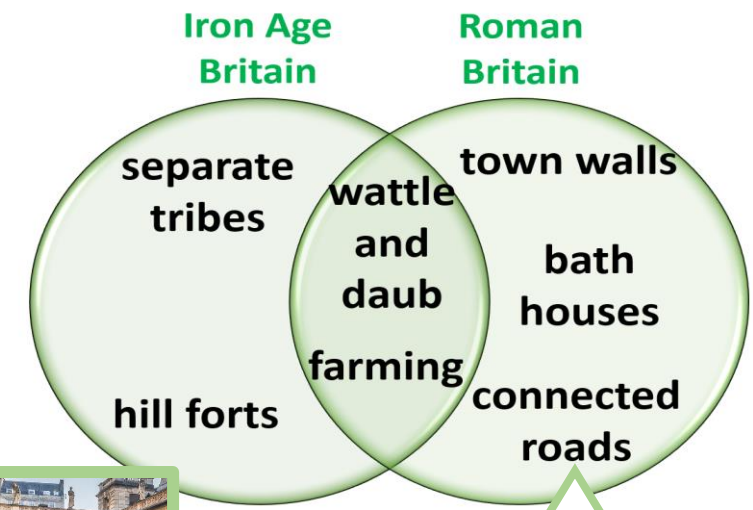


Historical sources recount Boudicca's Revolt differently.
