






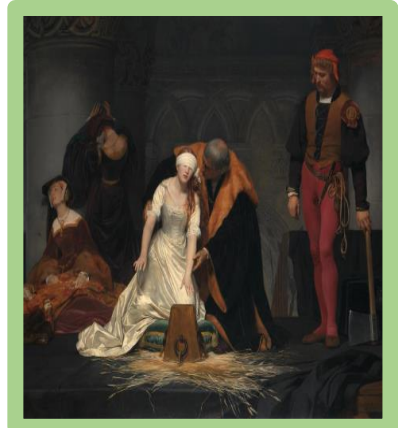
Lady Jane Grey

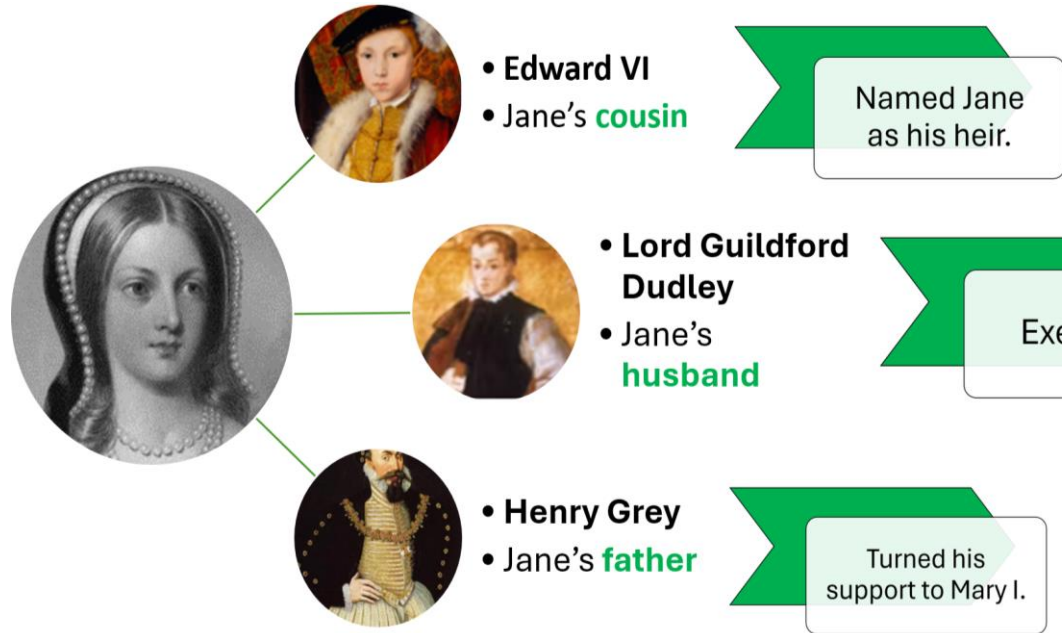

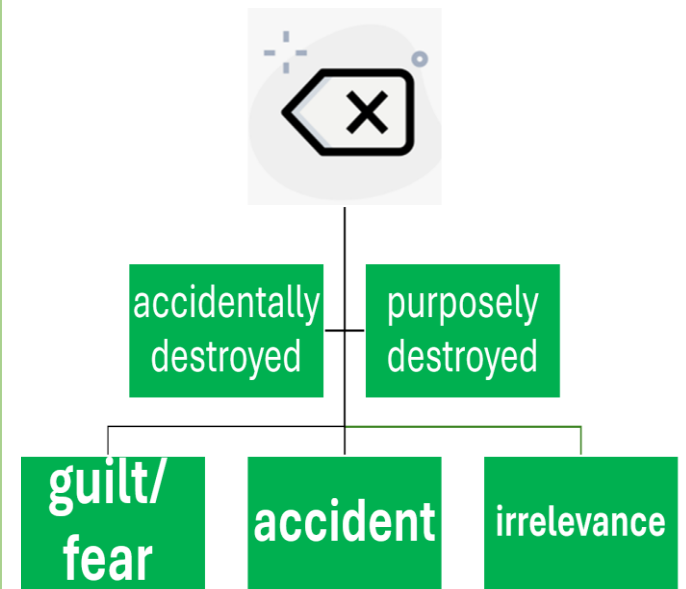
