Important People

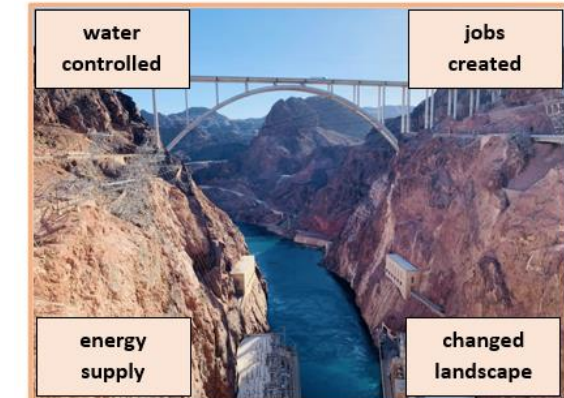
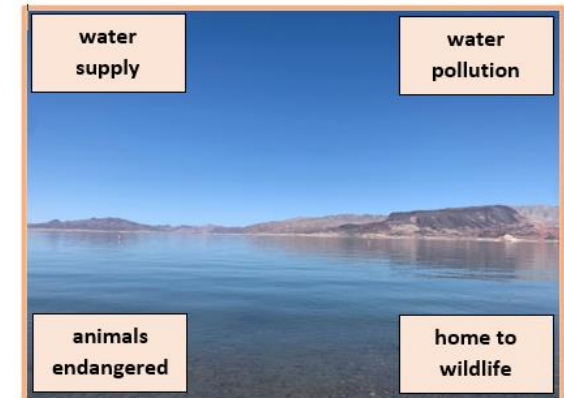
Arthur P. Davis
