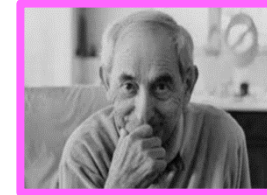

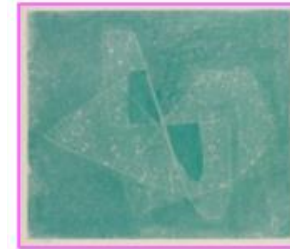

Big Ws: Printing

How to make a **monoprint**:

Step 1:

Use a **roller** to evenly **roll out** **paint** onto the **surface**.



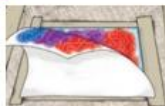
Step 2:

Make **marks** in the paint using objects.



Step 3:

Place a **clean piece of paper** on top of the wet paint. Add **pressure** using a **clean roller**.



How to make a **mono block print**:

Step 1:

Get a **polyblock**. Use a sharp pencil to **score** your design.



Step 2:

Apply **paint** onto your block using a sponge **roller**.



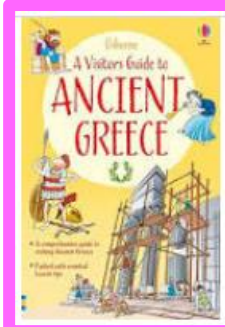
Step 3:

Print your block onto a **piece of paper**. Use a clean roller to add **pressure**.



Step 4:

Peel off the paper to reveal your print.
