

Big Ws: Rocks

igneous rock

- Contain crystals.
- Some have holes from **bubbles** when the rock formed.

metamorphic rock

> Often have grains that are all in the same direction.

sedimentary rock

- **Grains of sediment** squashed together.
- Can contain pebbles, crushed shells, bones, pieces of coral and fish poo.






