### Secondary Industry



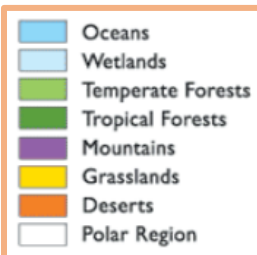
Takes the natural resources and **process them** into **goods** and **products (factories)**.
