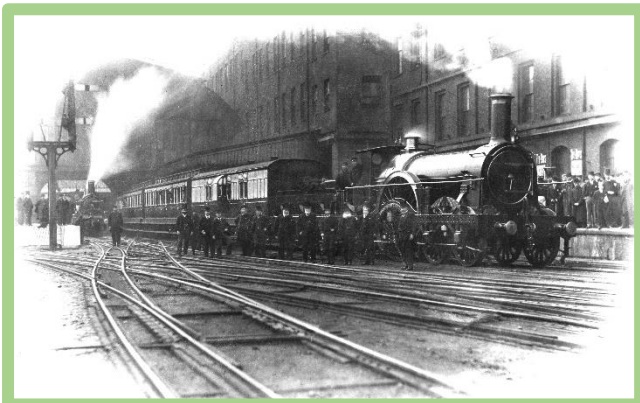

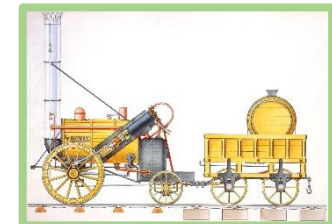

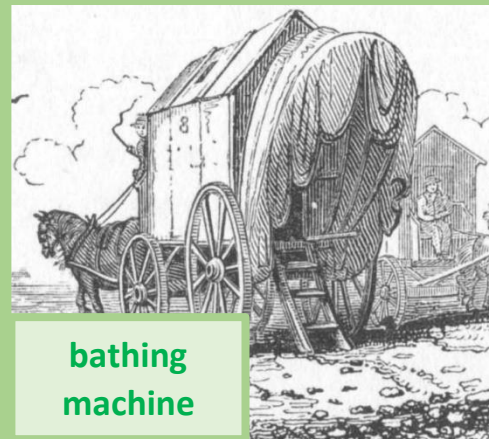
**George Stephenson**
